

# Week 3 – David and Saul

## Resources Needed

Thick card cut into harp shapes

Wool

## Welcome, Registration and Toilet Time

## Memory Verse

Bless those who persecute you. Romans 12v14

Gap fill/Hangman on large paper or whiteboard and explain key words.

## Bible Story

David and Saul – 1 Samuel 18, 19, 24, 26

## Prayer Time

Circle time – pass a small object around the circle and forgive others who have hurt or upset us.

## Worship

Suggested Song – Glory and Honour (Okey Dokey DVD – Doug Horley)

## Game

Fishes swim – each child to place their chair in a circle facing outwards. An adult to give each child a fish, either Cod, Mackerel or Haddock. Then the leader calls 'Cod swim' and those who are Cod 'swim' (walk) around the outside of the circle, the leader can also call 'turn tide' and all the fish swimming change direction. When the leader calls 'shark coming' the children have to keep going in the same direction and go back to their seat as quickly as they can.

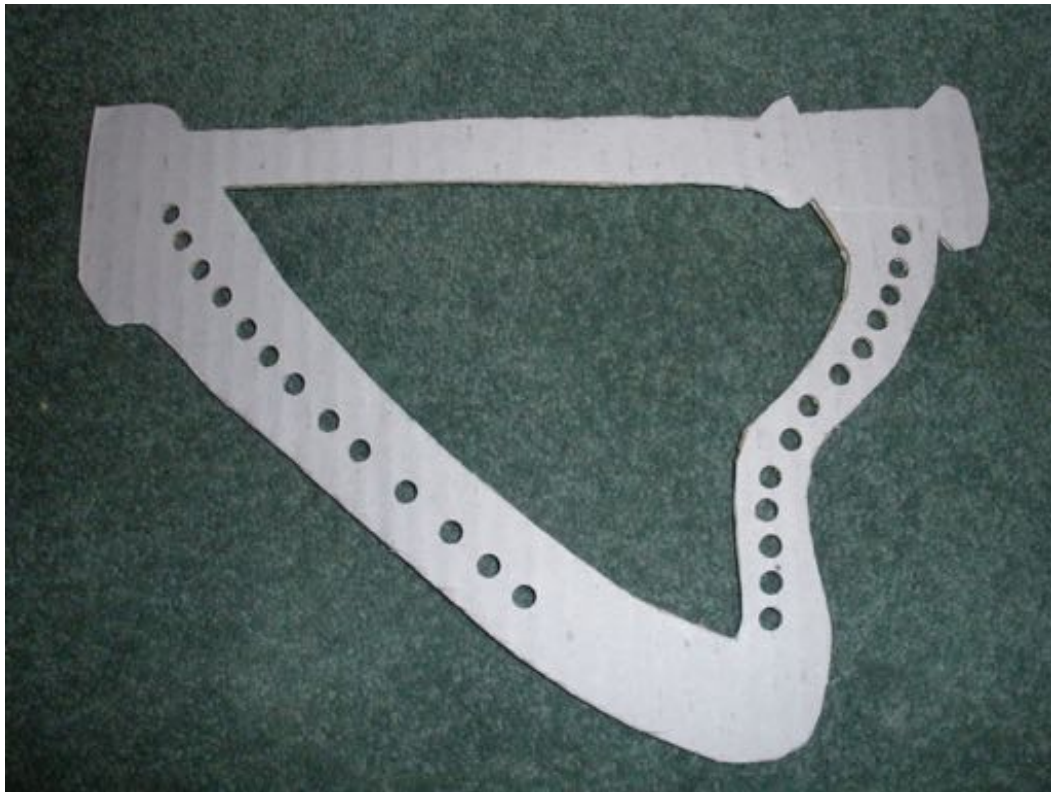
## Activity

Give each child a harp shape and some coloured wool. The children can thread the wool through the holes to make a harp.

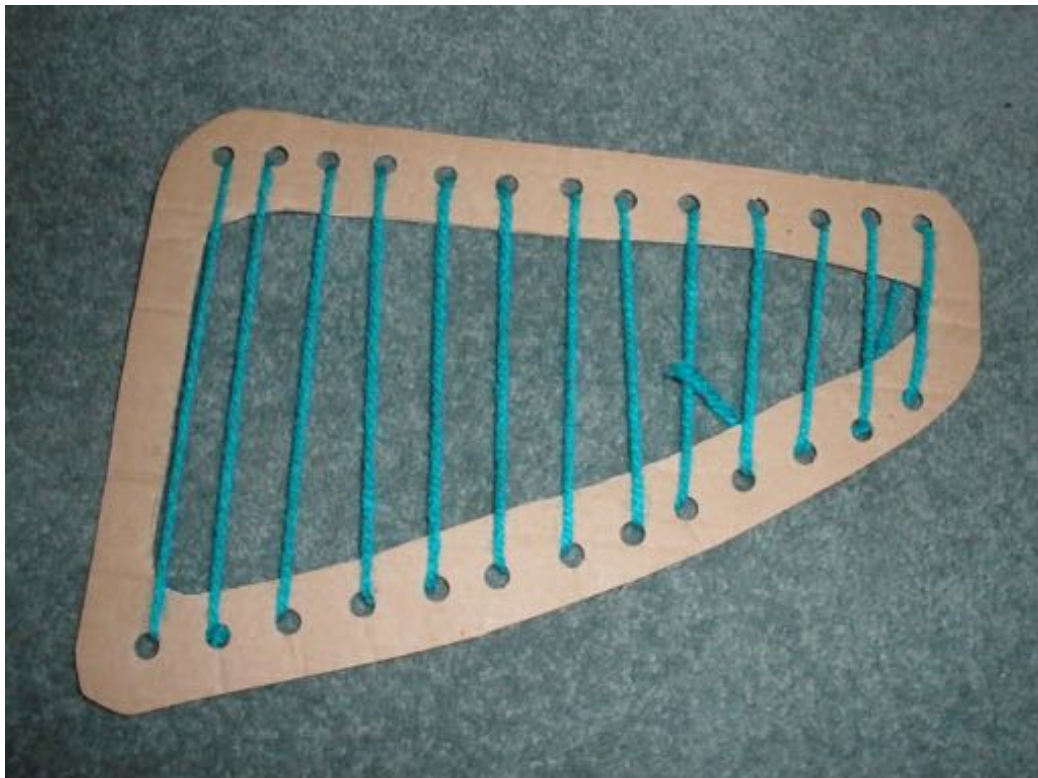
TIP – In order to differentiate for different age groups try using less holes for the younger children and more for the older children.
